

## NUMERACY

To add and subtract numbers up to 5, and start to learn by heart number bonds up to 5.

To count forwards and backwards in 1s to 20.

To start becoming familiar with counting in 2s.

To count up to 10 objects accurately.

To recognise coins, and become confident at using 1p and 2p.

Use Mathematical language to describe direction and position. To programme simple commands for a robot.

To start to use non standard units of measurement, and compare objects to say longer/shorter, full/empty, and heavier/lighter.

## OTHER CURRICULAR AREAS

To learn the names of the young farm animals (duckling, calf etc)

To learn about food and other things that are produced from farm animals.

To find out about garden birds and how to look after them.

## LITERACY

To speak clearly about things that interest them (e.g. show and tell) and to contribute to class discussions. To listen carefully with increasing concentration, and to start to ask questions.

To learn sight words and start reading books. To order events in a story and re-tell stories. To learn poetry by heart.

Phonics and handwriting – learning to build simple words and form the letters using the cursive style of handwriting.

To understand and start to use different forms of writing – such as news, a map, a labelled picture, a letter, a list.

To understand simple commands and start speaking simple Welsh sentences, using farm vocabulary.
