

LITERACY

- **Factual Report** – Write a factual report on an insect of their choice.
- **Story** – Write a story on a particular title.
- **Formal Letter** – Write a formal letter on a specific situation e.g. Christmas toy failed to arrive on time.
- **Book Report** – Write a book report on their favourite story. To be written on World Book day.
- **Poem** – Write a poem on an insect of their choice.
- **Personal Letter** – Write a letter to a friend listing their favourite activities of the theme.

ANY OTHER AREAS

Science – Creatures and habitats. Search the local environment for insects. Study different habitats in the local environment.

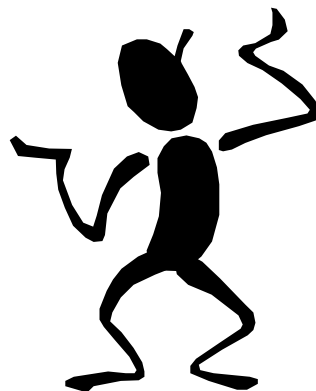
Visit from Animal Zone – A local company who display and present information on various bugs and insects.

Information for Parents 4C

These are examples of the skills your child will be learning this half term. They are not set in stone as the learning will be led by the children. These skills can be reinforced with your support by reading regularly with your child, practicing money skills when you shop, playing literacy games in the car, learning tables or by discussing news with your child. Thank you for your support.

NUMERACY

- **Money** - Using money to pay for items up to £ 10 and calculate the change. Compare and put items in order up to a £100. Adding and subtracting totals less than £10 by using the correct notation.
- **Fractions** - Recognizing that a number of parts make up a whole number e.g. $\frac{2}{3}$, $\frac{3}{10}$. Use fraction notation. Discover fractions of shapes. Detect fractional amounts using known facts on times tables e.g. $\frac{1}{6}$ of 30. Recognize fractions that are several parts of a whole number.
- **Time** - Read hours and minutes on a 24 hour digital clock. Convert times between a 12 hour and a 24 hour clock. Estimate how many minutes everyday activities are taking.
- **Negative numbers** - Identify negative whole numbers on a number line. Order whole numbers between -10 and 10. Identify temperature readings using thermometers and interpret readings above and below 0°C.
