

## NUMERACY

- Read and write numbers to 100,000.
- Use mental strategies to recall multiplication tables and use to solve division problems.
- Calculate area and perimeter.
- Multiply and divide 2 digits by 2 digits, and also 3 digits by 1 digit.
- Time - Read and use analogue and digital clocks. Calculate start times, finish times and durations using hours and minutes.
- Shape and angles - Recognise acute and obtuse angles. Recognise and classify triangles, using their own criteria.
- Manage money - Order and compare the cost of items up to £1000. Add and subtract totals less than £100 using correct notation, *e.g.*  $£28.18 + £33.45$ . Plan and track money and savings by keeping accurate records.

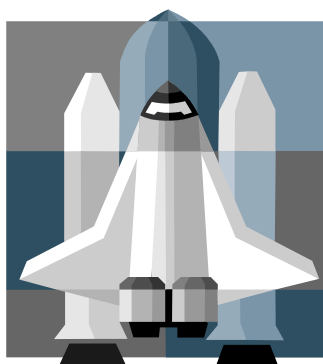
## OTHER CURRICULAR AREAS

## LITERACY

English genres to be covered this half term -
