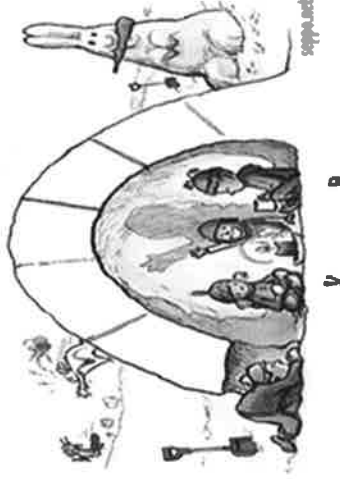


NUMERACY

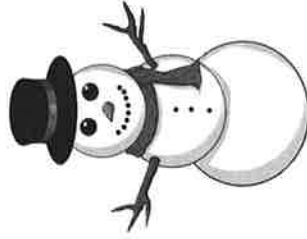
- Recite a range of Welsh number songs and rhymes.
- Count reliably up to 10 objects.
- Understand number value.
- Recite numbers up to 20, forwards and backwards, and from different starting points.
- Combine two groups of objects to find 'how many altogether'
- Take away objects to find 'how many are left?'
- Practice writing numbers in the sand, paint, with pencils and glue.
- Use 2D and 3D shapes to make models and pictures.
- Count birds around the school and create a simple graph.
- Compare the lengths of different objects.
- Match pairs of gloves.
- Use Numicon to understand and recognise

LITERACY

- Read and discuss stories about winter such as, Un Diwrnod Oer. Allan Yn Yr Eira. Ar Goll Yn Yr Eira. Eira Oer a Gwlyb.
- Role play in the snow cave
- Read simple words such as consonant-vowel-consonant words. (Tric a Chlic).
- Read and discuss factual books about arctic animals.
- Learn songs about the winter.
- Write cards, lists and simple descriptions.
- Practice forming letters correctly
- Use pictures and symbols to compose writing on-screen using computers and i pads.
- Use 'Cyw, Tric a Chlic a Ffrindiau'r wyddor' on the computer and i pad to develop literacy and numeracy skills.
- Recognise the alphabetic nature of writing and understand that written symbols have meaning.



These are examples of the skills your child will be learning this half term. They are not set in stone as the learning will be led by the children. These skills can be reinforced with your support by reading regularly with your child, practicing money skills when you shop, playing literacy games in the car, learning tables or by discussing news with your child.
